Provide on average, 200 backpacks and school supplies to refugee and underserved children in Buffalo, NY (yearly: 2019-2022).



100 meals served monthly to orphans in the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC).



On average, 60 orphans in the Democratic Republic of Congo are paired with an educational sponsor each school year.




Six orphans successfully graduated high school:
